Dear Mike,

We received a call today from the American Pool Virginia office that this student had an incident at his pool while at work today. From the information we have gathered it appears Mr. Fijalkowski became very aggressive and argumentative with a patron at the pool, his local supervisor was called and could not calm him down. At some point the police were called and when the police were there the EV reportedly attempted to kill himself by drowning himself in the pool. The police on the scene would not let the supervisor rescue him until he was no longer moving in the pool as not to threaten the safety of the supervisor. The EV was rescued, was not breathing but did have a pulse. He was taken by ambulance to a local hospital. He was conscious in the ambulance and became very combative and physical with the medical staff. He had to be sedated. Aside from his mental health, which he is being monitored for now at Fairfax hospital, he has not sustained any injuries related to holding himself under water.
