## **DECLARATION OF VICTOR M. GLASBERG**

- I, Victor M. Glasberg, plaintiff's counsel herein, declare under penalty of perjury that the following is true. For ease of reference, the paragraph numbers in this declaration track the paragraph numbers of the complaint to which they refer.
- 8. The document attached to the complaint as Exhibit 1 is a true copy of the marriage license application form available on line from the office of the Clerk of the Arlington, Virginia Circuit Court, with the drop-down menu of races from which one is to be selected. 9. The document attached to the complaint as Exhibit 2 is a true copy of the list of racial categories made available by the office of the Clerk of the Rockbridge, Virginia Circuit Court to persons seeking a marriage license from that court, and specifically, to plaintiffs Sophie Rogers

and Brandyn Churchill or or about Septembver 3, 2019.1

- 13. The documents attached to the complaint as Exhibit 3 are true copies of portions of the book *Systema Naturae* by Carl Linnaeus, referring to his division of *homo sapiens* into four major groups: *Americanus, Asiaticus, Africanus* and *Europeanus*, in the Latin original and in English translation. This text is widely available on line and in college and university libraries.
- 33-39. The work of Walter Plecker discussed in the complaint is addressed in the declarations of Thomas Guglielmo of George Washington University and Paul A. Lombardo of George State University filed herewith. - 61. The document attached to the complaint as Exhibit 19 comprises data available on line from the State Registrar's Office regarding statistics on marriage. The year 2013 is the most recent for which yearly statistics are currently posted. This document was produced to the undersigned by the State Registrar in response to a request under the Freedom of Information Act.
- 62-63. The Virginia Registrar has confirmed to the undersigned, pursuant to prelitigation requests made under Virginia's Freedom of Information Act, that (1) The Division of Vital Statistics provides only the number of Virginia marriages to the National Center for Health Statistics, not any racial data; (2) no study has been conducted by the Virginia Department of Health regarding the racial data collected from Virginia marriage records; and (3) no racial data regarding marriages has been the subject of data sharing requests directed to the Division by third parties.
